# **Huck Finn from Tom Sawyer**

In this monologue, HUCK FINN tells his best friend, Tom, why he'd rather be an orphan than be adopted by the widow and give up his freedom.

I've tried it, and it don't work, Tom. It ain't for me. The widow's good to me, and friendly; but I can't stand her ways. She makes me get up at the same time every morning, she makes me wash and comb my hair. She won't let me sleep in the woodshed. I got to wear those darn clothes that just smother me, Tom. They're so nice that I can't sit down, or lay down, or roll around. The widow eats by a bell; she goes to bed by a bell; she gets up by a bell -- everything's so regular I can't stand it. Tom, it doesn't make any difference that everybody does it. I'm not everybody. No, Tom, I won't be rich, and I won't live in those fancy houses. I like the woods, and the river, and I'll stick to 'em.

# **Fairytale Character from Shrek**
