- 1. Listen to the VOCAL GUIDE version of "One Short Day" from Wicked and sing along with the characters singing on the track.
- 2. You may like to use the lyric sheet to learn the song. You are welcome to do both the spoken and sung lines!
- 3. Please note that this is a shortened version of the original song (we had to edit due to time constraints). If you've sung this song before, you may notice a section or two missing. Please sing the song as it is in this edited version.
- 4. Practice, practice! Pay particular attention to the tempo (how fast or slow the song is) at different parts of the song.
- 5. When you are ready, try singing the song using the INSTRUMENTAL version of the song (without the characters singing). Sing any and all of the parts!
- 6. When you feel ready, record yourself singing along to the INSTRUMENTAL version.
- 7. Don't worry about singing the song perfectly. We will be editing together the recordings of students singing, so if you mess up a certain part, we'll simply use your recording for a different part of the song. Have fun, be silly, be yourself, and sing out!
