

## MUSICAL THEATRE SINGING CHALLENGE

1. Listen to the VOCAL GUIDE version of “One Short Day” from Wicked and sing along with the characters singing on the track.
2. You may like to use the lyric sheet to learn the song. You are welcome to do both the spoken and sung lines!
3. Please note that this is a shortened version of the original song (we had to edit due to time constraints). If you’ve sung this song before, you may notice a section or two missing. Please sing the song as it is in this edited version.
4. Practice, practice, practice! Pay particular attention to the tempo (how fast or slow the song is) at different parts of the song.
5. When you are ready, try singing the song using the INSTRUMENTAL version of the song (without the characters singing). Sing any and all of the parts!
6. When you feel ready, record yourself singing along to the INSTRUMENTAL version.
7. Don’t worry about singing the song perfectly. We will be editing together the recordings of students singing, so if you mess up a certain part, we’ll simply use your recording for a different part of the song. Have fun, be silly, be yourself, and sing out!
